SEARCHING FOR CLASSES

- 1. Location** – Select Madera Community College or Oakhurst Center.
- 2. Term** – Select the term you want to take the class in.
- 3. Courses and Sections** – Select the “Subject” of the class you want to take, enter the “Course Number” and leave the “Section” blank.
 - Example: ENGL 1A, subject is “English” and the course number is “1A.”
- 4. Search** – Click the “Search” button at the bottom of the screen.

UNDERSTANDING THE SEARCH RESULTS PAGE

Section Status Column

- Open – Means there are spots available in the class.
- Waitlisted – Means the class is full and students are put on a waitlist to get in to the class if spots become available.
- Closed – Means the class and waitlist are full already.

Availability Column

- First number listed – Amount of spots currently available in the class.
- Second number listed – The maximum amount of students allowed in the class.
- Third number listed – The number of students on the waitlist.

UNDERSTANDING DATES AND LOCATION INFORMATION

Dates Column

Be aware of the class start and end date. Full-term 18-week classes run August through December in the fall and January through May in the spring.

- Short-term and/or late-start classes end earlier or start later each term, but cover the same amount of information as full-term 18-week classes.

Summer Dates

Summer classes usually begin in late May for 4 and 10-week classes, and June for 6 and 8-week classes.

- Summer 4-week classes are not recommended for HSE students because these classes run during your high school finals in the spring.

Location Column

The listed location is where that class will take place.

- Madera Community College – Class will take place in-person on the college campus.
- Madera Hybrid – Class will take place in-person on the college campus and also online.
- Madera 100% Online – Class will take place completely online.
 - Online classes may or may not have regularly scheduled meetings times that will take place via Zoom. (This will be explained on the next slide.)



UNDERSTANDING MADERA 100% ONLINE INFORMATION

Instructional Methods Column

When “Madera 100% Online” is listed under the Location column, the class is an online class. The Instructional Methods column will let you know if that class has any regularly scheduled meeting times or not; “LEC Internet” or “LEC Simultaneous Internet.”

- **LEC Internet** - No regularly scheduled meeting times. All class information will be available in Canvas.
- **LEC Simultaneous Internet** – Regularly scheduled meeting days and times that you will have to attend online via Zoom. The instructor will provide this information via an email, in their class syllabus, or in Canvas.
 - Meeting days and times will be located in the Meeting Information column.

Meeting Information Column

This is where you can find the days, times, building, and room location for when and where your class will meet.

Madera Community College (Location):

- Meeting Information will list days, times, building and room location.

Madera 100% Online (Location):

- Lec Internet (Instructional Methods) – Meeting Information will list “Times TBD”, but there are no meetings days/times for this class.
- LEC Simultaneous Internet (Instructional Methods) – Meeting Information will list days and times meeting will take place online via Zoom.

Madera Hybrid (Location):

- Meeting Information will list days, times, building and room location for in-person meetings and “Times TBD” for the online portion of the class.

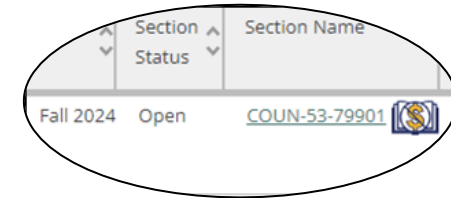


ADDITIONAL SECTION DETAILS

- **Course Description** – A description of what will be covered in the class listed and what degree, general education, and/or transfer requirements the class meets.
- **Books** – You can click on the Bookstore Information link to see what textbook(s) or materials are needed for the class.

Important Reminders When Listing Classes

- Be sure to include the 5-digit section number, course title, and the number of units for each class.
- HSE students are only allowed to take up to 11 units per semester.
- We can only process Madera Community College or Oakhurst Center classes for registration.
 - Fresno City College, Reedley College, or Clovis Community College classes must be submitted to that college's HSE program for processing.

Listing the Same Class Twice

You may want to list the same class twice in case the class you want is almost full, but there is another section that has more spots available. We will try registering you for the first class, but if it is full then we will automatically try registering you for the other section listed.
